Lyophilized Powder Delivery Form: Pre-lyophilization buffer is Tris/PBS-based buffer containing 6% Trehalose.

4. Storage Conditions

Upon receipt, store the product at -20°C or -80°C. It is recommended to aliquot the protein for multiple uses to avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles, which may cause

5. Product Description

This product is a recombinant Human MIS12 full length protein (1-205aa) expressed in E.coli. The protein is with 6xHis-SUMO tag at the N-terminus, which facilitates protein purification, detection and identification. MIS12, also known as MTW1 or hMis12 or KNTC2AP, is suitable for related in vitro functional assays, protein interaction studies, antibody preparation and other biomedical research applications.
