This product is a recombinant Human AGA partial protein (24-205aa) expressed in E.coli. The protein is with 6xHis-SUMO tag at the N-terminus, which facilitates protein purification, detection and identification. AGA, also known as GA or AGU or ASRG, is suitable for related in vitro functional assays, protein interaction studies, antibody preparation and other biomedical research applications.
