This product is a recombinant Human NME1 full length of mature protein protein (2-152aa) expressed in E.coli. The protein is with GST tag at the N-terminus, which facilitates protein purification, detection and identification. NME1, also known as NB or AWD or NBS, is suitable for related in vitro functional assays, protein interaction studies, antibody preparation and other biomedical research applications.
