Upon receipt, store the product at -20°C or -80°C. It is recommended to aliquot the protein for multiple uses to avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles, which may cause protein denaturation and activity loss.

This product is a recombinant Mouse ADCK2 partial protein expressed in Yeast. The protein is tag-free. ADCK2, also known as aarF domain containing kinase putative ubiquinone biosynthesis protein AarF, is suitable for related in vitro functional assays, protein interaction studies, antibody preparation and other biomedical research applications.
