This product is a recombinant Human IL20RB partial protein (30-233aa) expressed in Mammalian cell. The protein is with 10xHis tag at the C-terminus, which facilitates protein purification, detection and identification. IL20RB, also known as DIRS1 or FNDC6 or IL-20R2, is suitable for related in vitro functional assays, protein interaction studies, antibody preparation and other biomedical research applications.
